From my first day of kindergarten I struggled with reading and spelling, but my short-term memory and my auditory comprehension and retention was very strong, so I got through school, though my grades were less than impressive. In my final semester of graduate school, after failing two language classes, a friend encouraged me to get tested for dyslexia. It had been a question in my mind since I had first heard about it on TV as a kid. So I got tested. Sure enough, I was diagnosed with dyslexia. My psychologist who did my testing did not know what to do to help me since I was older and finishing graduate school.

From there I moved to Saint Cloud, to take my first teaching position. As a teacher, I helped identify students who were struggling with dyslexia.
